FRIDAY & SATURDAY MORNING CHECK OUT GUIDE

PROCEDURE:

ON FRIDAY:

- Please pay your **bill** at the administration office, at the time listed on the front of this sheet. Please do not forget.
- If you wish, you may order a Friday evening **Equipment Barge**. Contact Administration.

ON SATURDAY:

1. Your 'Check Out' time is listed on the reverse side of this sheet. If a change in time is required, please call Administration, (but no later than Friday noon).
2. An Inspection Team will arrive at the appointed time. They will be examining the items listed below.
3. The barge(s) will arrive only after the site passes inspection. Please be patient, we have many troops to transport.
4. Please be prepared with a "Work-Party Chain" to load the barge quickly.

LEAVING A CAMPSITE 'READY' FOR THE NEXT TROOP

1. Kybos are to be filled in with rocks and earth and marked with a cross.
2. Grease pits are to be filled in and marked with a cross.
3. Kybos are to be scrubbed (inside & out) with javex and water and left near the dock. Please wash the kybos away from the shore.
4. Extinguish all fires until the wood, and ground beneath is cold.
5. Please remove all glass and tinfoil from all firepits.
6. Wash down all tables.
7. Clean the ground cooler & prop lid open.
8. If you 'Trenched' your tents, fill in all trenches.
9. Have the whole troop, 'walk' the campsite and pick up all litter.
10. Bring all garbage to the main end on your barge.
11. Tie all rowboats to the shore, away from the water side of the dock.
12. When leaving, please have your youth dressed to portray the Scouting image.
